

CHECKLIST

To help identify intimate scenes in a script or production.

For following contents early consultation of an intimacy coordinator is recommended:

Nudity / Partial nudity		Any simulated sexual interaction between minors or minors and adults ***
(Simulated) kissing		
Touch on the body		Intimate scenes with external specialists (strippers, sex workers, consultants out of BDSM community,)
Simulated sexual interactions		Simulated sexual interactions performed by extras
Simulated consensual sex		Potential strong power imbalances between performers or director and performers (age, gender, POC, LGBTQIA+, professional experience, degree of popularity)
Simulated self-stimulation		
Simulated stimulation of another person by hand		
Simulated oral stimulation		Intimate scenes in public spaces or with a big amount of performers on set/stage, which challenge the concept of closed set
Simulated sexual interaction with an object
